The completed packet of information must be: computer-generated *or* legibly printed and returned to the scholarship chair at the address listed on the application, postmarked by March 15, 2024 to be eligible for consideration.

Applicants for the <u>Bittersweet Garden Club Scholarship</u> must:

- Live within the Jefferson City trade area,
- Be a graduating high school senior,
- Have at least a "B" average, and
- Plan to major in one of the following fields of study: Agronomy, Agriculture Education, Floriculture, Horticulture, Landscape Design, Botany/Biology, Forestry, Wildlife Science, Plant Pathology/Science, City (Rural & Urban) Planning, Habitat or Forest/Systems Ecology, Environmental Concerns, Environmental Conservation, Land Management, and/or other related or allied subjects.
